He was born in April 1967 and is originally from Long Island, New York, where he was born and raised. Portnoy is also a composer. The all-talented artist has been voted as one of the best American drummers of all time. 8. Mike Lombardo Fans of the heavy metal band Slayer will easily recognize the name Mike Lombardo. The Cuban-American drummer is one of the original founding members of Slayer. After touring with the band and playing for nine Slayer albums, he left the band, but did not retire. With a successful musical career of over 40 years, he has played for several bands, appearing on 35 commercial recordings of different genres. He has played for other bands such as Suicidal Tendencies, Testament, Philm, Fantomas, Grip Inc. and others. The 7. Lars Ulrich is a Danish musician born in 1963. He is also cofounder of the American band Metallica. He comes from a family of professional tennis players. He also had a passion for the sport. When he met James Hetfield and formed Metallica, his career goals underwent a sudden change. Ulrich is also a composer who has to almost all the songs Metallica recorded. 6. John Bonham was an Englishmanand musician who served as drummer of the heavy metal band Led Zeppelin. He was one of the most powerful and fastest rhythmic men in the business during his era in the 70s. Bonham died in September 1980, but not before leaving his mark on the world. He has become revered as one of the best and most influential drummers in the history of rock and heavy metal music. He started playing drums at the tender age of five. When he was 15, he played for local bands. He was destined to become a pro. He died at the age of 32 and left a huge hole in the hearts of bandmates and fans, but his legacy is hard. 5.
